

Salmon fishing in a river! A unique opportunity!

Salmon fishing in the Hamansu River is normally prohibited but an exception has been made for research, to the delight of local fishing fans. The fish are inspected, and data is collected on the number of salmon runs. Fishing volunteers are wanted! Applications may be submitted in June, and the investigation is conducted starting in early September. Why don't you give it a try?

Gokibiru Trail



This 11km long mountain road was constructed between Yasosuke and Gokibiru in the Edo period. Closed since the construction of highway 231, this trail has recently been reopened after being repaired by the Gokibiru Trail Preservation Group. Now it is known as a lovely trekking course.


